2021 LEGION MASTERS REGATTA
LAKE KARAPIRO – SATURDAY 8th MAY
REGATTA RULES OF RACING AND CONDITIONS
SAFETY BRIEFING at 8.00 a.m -
A Club Representative must attend.
Racing will begin at 9.00 a.m.

1. **Generally:** The Regatta shall be conducted in accordance with the NZRA Rules of Racing 2020 (Rule 6.1), and shall be governed by applicable Articles of the Constitution of the New Zealand Rowing Association Inc. Further: this regatta shall be conducted in accordance with the Rowing NZ Water Safety Code and the Rowing New Zealand Competition Safety Code (Rule 6.2), together with the Karapiro Rowing Inc. Safety Plan, of which the contents and intent take precedent over all other documents.
2. **Regatta Entry:** Will only be via rowIT <http://rowit.nz/akmm2021/entry>
3. **Fees:**
 1. Legion Member – Rower fee is \$30.
 2. All non-members - \$50 per rower.
 3. Coxswain Only (non-rower) – No Charge.
 4. The Legion will invoice fees to each Club for the Legion regatta fees.
 5. Rowing NZ Competitors' licences are not required for this regatta.
4. **Masters' Classification:** The age of a rower in a masters rowing event shall be their age as at 31st December 2021.
The crew age categories are:

A.	Minimum age:	27 years
B.	Average age:	36 years or more
C.	Average age:	43 years or more
D.	Average age:	50 years or more
E.	Average age:	55 years or more
F.	Average age:	60 years or more
G.	Average age:	65 years or more
H.	Average age:	70 years or more
I.	Average age:	75 years or more
J.	Average age:	80 years or more
K.	Average age:	85 years or more

Age categories do not apply to coxswains of master's crews.
5. **Important. Please note the following:**
 - **Where a race contains crews of mixed grades**, a handicap may be imposed on the younger graded crews – at the Starter's discretion.
 - **Each competitor** shall be responsible for his/her own health and fitness.
 - **Every rower** must be able to prove his/her age with the presentation of an official document (Driver's Licence, etc.), if required.
 - **The Age Category** of a Masters' crew must be calculated by the average age of the crew.
 - **All Age Groups**, as listed, will be catered for at this Masters' Regatta.

- **Coxed Boats** can enter in a coxless event. A handicapping system may apply.
 - **All Mixed masters, and New Masters events, as well as the final 2 events – Women’s Eight and Men’s Eight are Open age events.**
6. **New Masters Classification:** A New Masters rower is a rower who has not competed in a race prior to 1st September 2020. (Check Legion May '20 newsletter for full rules)
 7. **School Parent Classification:** A School Parent rower is a rower of any status. All rowers in this classification must have had a child attend the school they are representing. Rowers may be New Masters or Experienced Masters. An equal number of men and women will be in each crew. Multiple crews from each school may be entered. Requirements of School Parent events must be observed.
 8. **Open Classification:** For an Open event – Age groupings do not apply.
 9. **Composite Crews:** Members from different Clubs may make up a crew in any event (including for doubles and/or pairs), and any such mixed crews must wear their own Club colours.
 10. **Mixed Crews Events:** A crew participating in a mixed event must be made up of an equal number of Male and Female members.
 11. **Coxswains:** Coxswains **MUST** wear fitted non-inflatable life jackets. The minimum weight for coxswains is 55 kgs. Coxswains may be of either gender.
 12. **Races:** Depending on the level of entries for an event, some events may have to be combined in a single race. Each crew is required to carry an identifying bow number. Numbers will be provided by the regatta organizers.
 13. **All New Masters Races:** Must be raced with a Coxswain, in Coxed boats.
 14. **Late entries:** No late entries will be accepted after the close-off date, and No entries will be accepted during the regatta.
 15. **Any crew changes:** Due to medical issues, must have been made at least one hour prior to the start of that event, and the substituted rower must be the same gender and the same age (or older).
 16. **Any scrutchings:** must be made at the Secretary’s office at least one hour prior to the start of the event.
 17. **Course Description:** All races will be 1000 metres in length, and over a buoyed 7 wire, 6 lane, straight course with an aligned start. (Where volunteer boat holders are available, there will be held starts). The water for all intents and purposes is to be considered as still and without flow. Lane 1 shall be closest to the Judges Tower.
