2008 BANK LINK –LEGION MASTERS & CORPORATE ROWING REGATTA 2008. LAKE PUPUKE Auckland CONDITIONS

- 1. This Regatta will be conducted in accord with the NZRA rules of racing and Water Safety Codes except where amended by these regatta conditions
- 2. All rowers must register with the Regatta Secretary before the start of Event 1.
- Masters, New Masters & Corporate rower's registration fee is \$20 per Rower
- Proof of age required if requested for masters competitors (eg Drivers Licence etc).
 A Masters rower will be placed in the age category corresponding to the age that he or she attains during the current year (from Jan1 to Dec31)
- 4. Members from different Clubs may make up a crew and mixed crews may wear their own Club colours.
- 5. Event 9, 15, 17, 21. (Mixed Fours, Corp Eight Doubles & Quads) crews must be made up of equal numbers of Male & Female members.
- 6. Coxswains MUST wear life jackets. The minimum weight for coxswains is 50 kgs All coxswains MUST weigh in before the first race.
- 7. Coxswains may be of either gender. There is no age classification for coxswains
- 8. Depending on entries events may be combined in one race.
- 9. Each crew is required to carry an identifying bow number. Numbers will be provided by the organisers. A \$5 refundable deposit will be required for each number.
- 10. The Umpire shall be in control of all races and his / her decision shall be final.
- 11. No 1 position as shown in this programme is that nearest to the starter.
- 12 A "New Masters Rower" is a rower who is aged over 27 years and is in their first regatta season. The majority of a new master's crew must meet the new master criteria
- 13 "A Corporate rower "is a rower of any status, the majority of the rowers in a corporate crew must be employees of the corporate. All members of a corporate crew must wear the same corporate uniform. Gender requirements of corporate events must be observed.
- 14 A Masters Rower is a rower aged over 27 years who is not competing in Premier events as per rule 12.2.4 of the NZRA
- 15 The age category of a Masters crew may be calculated by the average age of the crew.
- 16. Events 7, 15, 20 &22 are "open" events age, groupings do not apply.
- 17. The organisers will endeavour to limit races to 8 boat fields by scheduling additional races as required, men's and women's events will be rowed as separate races if entries allow
- 17. All four oared (4+) & eight oared (8+)boats shall carry a coxswain
- 18. Late entries accepted at the discretion of the Regatta Controller
- 19. All races will be held over a distance of approximately 1000 metres

20. "Exclusion of all tort liability of whatsoever kind"
