If you wish to reserve one of these then please indicate so on the entry form and enclose a separate cheque. Your cheque will be returned if you are unsuccessful. We will mark out as many additional tent sites near the water as permitted by North Shore City Council – all others will have to be sited in the boat park area.

To ensure we can accommodate everyone comfortably within the limited space available in the boat park, spaces will be allocated to each Club based on the size of your squad etc. A map showing allocations will be displayed on the gate to the boat park area.
