The Regatta Programme will provide heats for all events on day one and finals on day two. Should any competitor wish to attend one day only, ie heats day or finals day, this will be accepted. On the finals day however one day competitors will be confined to remaining empty lanes after two day competitors have been catered for.

There will be 4 shoot out sprint races, over 250m (from the bridge) - a single, mixed double, mixed quad and an 8, where clubs can race for a prize which will go to their club. Expressions of interest from adaptive athletes welcome and races will be organised according to interest.



CONDITIONS of Entry



This is a Non-Status Regatta and is conducted under the current Rowing New Zealand Rules of Racing subject to the following Conditions

- 1. All crews to row in their club colours.
- 2. The minimum weight of all coxswains is 55kg.
- 3. Scratchings must be handed to the regatta secretary by 8.00 am on race day.
- 4. Crews are to be positioned in the lanes shown in the programme or as allocated on the day.
- 5. Crews are to be at the Start Zone a minimum of five minutes prior to the scheduled Start time of their race. Crews late to the Start may be eliminated from the race.
- 6. No time allowance will be granted for a clash of events or boat use. Coaches must select the events to enter without relying on any time allowance.
- 7. All races will be started by horn. A second horn denotes a recall.
- 8. Crews proceeding to the start must keep to the Clive Township side of the course.
- 9. All boats must be identified by a securely fixed bow number to indicate LANE number.
- 10. All crews and Boats must comply with NZRA Safety requirements and specifications including those provisions included in the Rules of Racing
- 11. Names of crew members and seeding information must accompany entries. All scratchings and substitutions of crew personnel must be made in writing to the Regatta Secretary at least one hour before the race. Entries must be made on official forms provided.
- 12. Assume that there will be divisions in each race. To assist with the draw, please give us a realistic assessment of which division each crew should start. A space is provided for this on the entry form. Where sufficient entries are received to justify dividing the field into divisions, handicapping may be applied to provide crews with quality racing.
- 13. The Hawkes Bay Rowing Club will not accept any liability for any accidents on race day.
- 14. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Hawkes Bay Regatta Committee.
- 15. Late entries: those received after 10 am, 22nd December 2012.
- 16. All entry fees must be paid prior to Racing.
- 17. Every effort will be made to maintain the published regatta programme, but the organising committee reserves the right to alter the schedule as deemed necessary.
