## Hawke's Bay Cup Regatta

*January 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015*

Clive River

**Start Time**      1:00pm on Friday the 2<sup>nd</sup> (twilight racing on the 2<sup>nd</sup>)  
8:30am on Saturday the 3<sup>rd</sup>

The final races of the second day will be a series of shootout races over 250 metres. There will be a Mens Single, Womens Single, Mixed Double, Quad, and Eight. Athletes can be in only one race for the shootout as the races are so quick fire there is no time to get athletes out in a second event. For the winner of each race the Hawke's Bay Rowing Club has put up **one hundred dollars (\$100) Prize Money**

The Regatta Programme will provide heats for all events on day one and finals on day two. Should any crew wish to attend one day only (i.e. heats day or finals day) this will be accepted. On the finals day however one-day competitors will be confined to remaining empty lanes after two-day competitors have been catered for.

Expressions of interest from adaptive athletes are welcome and races will be organised according to interest.

Entry fees are \$3 per sliding seat plus GST

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

*This is a Non-Status Regatta and is conducted under the current Rowing New Zealand Rules of Racing subject to the following Conditions*



1. All crews and boats must comply with NZRA Safety requirements and specifications including those provisions included in the Rules of Racing
2. All crews to row in their club colours.
3. All competitors must hold a current NZRA Competition Licence.
4. The minimum weight for all coxswains is 55kg.
5. Races will be no less than 1800 metres for the general programme. The last races, on Saturday 3 January, will be a series of **Shootout races over 250 metres.**
6. There will be shootout races for: Mens Single, Womens Single, Mixed Double, Quad, and Eight. Athletes can be in only one race for the shootouts as the races are so quick fire there is no time to get athletes out in a second event.
7. Racing will commence at 1:00pm on Friday 2 January making this a Twilight Event. Racing on the second day begins in the morning and will finish at approximately midday on Saturday 3 January. These times are to make best use of the tides.
8. Every effort will be made to maintain the published regatta programme, but the organising committee reserves the right to alter the schedule as deemed necessary.
9. **Scratchings** must be handed to the regatta secretary by 12:30pm day one and 8:00am day two.
10. All boats must be identified by a securely fixed bow number to indicate **lane number**.
11. Crews are to be positioned in the lanes shown in the programme or as allocated on the day.
12. Crews proceeding to the start must keep to the Clive Township side of the course.
13. Crews are to be at the Start Zone a minimum of five minutes prior to the scheduled Start time of their race. Crews late to the Start may be eliminated from the race.
14. No time allowance will be granted for a clash of events or boat use. Coaches must select the events to enter without relying on any time allowance.
15. All races will be started by horn. A second horn denotes a recall.
16. **Points** will be awarded for the Hawke's Bay Cup on the Basis of 3-2-1 for win-second-third.
17. **Prize money of \$100** has been put up by the Hawke's Bay Rowing Club for the winner of each shootout race.
18. **Entries** for the general programme **must be made online through [www.rowit.co.nz](http://www.rowit.co.nz)** (but entries for the shootout sprints can be made online or at the venue on the day).
19. **Entries will be taken from any Adaptive Athletes. Please email us and races will be organised accordingly.**
20. An RPC or the Summer Squad may enter any Open event.

21. Assume there will be divisions in each race. **Use crew numbers to self-seed your crews.**  
 ~ If your best crew is a division 2 crew start numbering from 2.  
 ~ If you use double-digit crew numbers the second digit will be used for seeding e.g. 1=11=21  
 Where sufficient entries are received to justify dividing the field into divisions, handicapping may be applied to provide crews with quality racing.
22. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Hawke's Bay Regatta Committee.  
 Late entries are those received **after 10pm, Monday 22rd December 2014.**
23. The online entry system may re-open to take late or supplementary entries and/or crew changes and/or scratchings. Entrants will be notified of the details if this happens.
23. Entry fees: \$24.00 Eight; \$12.00 Fours & Quads; \$6.00 Doubles; \$3.00 Singles
24. All entry fees must be paid prior to Racing. Accounts details:
