Draft Schedule and Supplementary Entries	Supplementary entries will open to fill available lanes in existing heats only when the draft schedule is published at 10:00am on Friday 8 December. The above entry limits will be progressively lifted. Supplementary entries will be charged the standard entry fees (not late entry fees).		
	Crews scratched before 8:00am on Thursday 14 December will not incur late scratching fees, and will be refunded their original entry fees.		
Progression	 Entries are to Finals only: 1- 8 entries: Preliminary Heats used (see below) 9-24 entries: two-round qualification system, Heats to A Finals only. Some B Finals may be offered at Regatta Control's discretion. 25+ entries: two-round qualification system, Heats to A and B Finals only. 49+ entries: Timed Heats will be used (see below). 		
Preliminary Heats	Regatta Control will expect you are racing a Preliminary Heats by default. If you wish to opt out, you must inform Regatta Control at least 60 mins before the scheduled race start time. If you fail to inform Regatta Control, the crew will be deemed a Did Not Start (which attracts a DNS penalty fee). All crews, other than crews Excluded or Disqualified from the Preliminary, will race the final. Crews that do not place in the Preliminary Heats will be randomly allocated outer lanes.		
Oversubscription	Due to the Timed Heats progression system option, events will not be considered oversubscribed. In the event that a given day, or the regattas as a whole is oversubscribed, the following may occur: Preliminary Heats removed, supplementaries do not open, races moved between days, minor finals removed, or rejection of entries starting with lowest numbered crews.		
Coxswain Weigh-In	Coxswains need to weigh in 1-2 hours before their first race of the regatta only, i.e. once for the whole regatta.		

Karāpiro Christmas Regatta: Entries Guidance

Please read the following information carefully and ensure you understand the <u>Table of Events</u> below before submitting entries for Christmas Regatta.

<u>Format</u>

Christmas Regatta has the following format:

Friday	Age-group heats (U15-U18) with Intermediate 1x heats interspersed in numerical order.	
Saturday	Remaining ability grade heats with selected age-group 8+ and 8x+ finals (to be confirmed when final schedule is published, see below) interspersed in numerical order .	
Sunday All ability grade finals with remaining age-group finals interspersed in numerical order		

On each day of the regatta, the events taking place on that day are compressed together **in numerical order without gaps** for events which do not take place on that day.

When entering athletes in a mix of age-group and ability grade events, it is important to check each day on the table of events below carefully to avoid clashes.

Age-group Finals

Coaches will see from the <u>table of events</u> that most age-group finals will definitely be raced on Sunday, but some age-group finals are shown as TBC*. Finals shown as TBC* will be raced on either Saturday or Sunday in their numerical order as indicated by the table. All ability-grade finals will be raced on Sunday.

The preference is to race the TBC* finals on Saturday if possible, however, this will depend on how many ability grade entries there are. The more ability grade entries there are, the more ability grade heats will need to be raced on Saturday, meaning more TBC* age-group finals will need to be moved to Sunday. We hope the flexibility to move some finals will allow us to avoid having to cancel Preliminary Heats.

Event Order

Coaches should use the table of events below to anticipate clashes before the draft schedule is published. When working out how far apart certain races may be, coaches should consider that:

- Heats for consecutive events could take place as little as 4 minutes apart if there is only one Preliminary Heat, or only an A final (no B final).
- It is highly recommended that each athlete's events are separated by at least 7 races on every day they could race those events. Events which are 8 apart on a given day, could be 8x4=32 minutes apart in a worst case (for example, 8 events next to each other, all with only one heat).
- Do not count 4 minutes for finals marked TBC* as these may move to the alternate day.
- There will not be gaps between races where a blank space is shown in the table of events.

Timed Heats

Timed Heats are heats which are seeded and raced side-by-side as normal, but progression to finals is determined using times rather than placings. For example, if we receive 70 entries in the BU17 1x competitors will race in 9 timed heats, and the crews with the 8 fastest times will progress to the A Final.

Christmas Regatta will give crews in events with more than 48 entries an opportunity to practice racing Timed Heats. These will be used later in the season at NIRC for heavily subscribed events. Place-based progression systems work best when heats are seeded fairly, however, many school crews will not have raced in ability events prior to NIRC, so seeding them will not be possible. If many crews are unseeded, some heats could be more competitive than others, and this becomes unfair when a place-based progression only allows 1 or 2 crews to progress from each heat.

Key Changes from 2022

- Mens and womens intermediate singles heats will take place on Friday.
- Ability grade events are aligned with the NIRC 2024 order of events.
- Club 4+ has changed to Club 4- in line with the NZCC programme of events.
