- All skiffs must carry bow numbers (will be supplied) and bow balls.
- All skiffs must carry lifer preservers for each crew member in every skiff.
- All coxswains must wear a life jacket.
- The bowman in each skiff must wear a Hi Vis Shirt or Vest.
- All skiffs must have quick release shoes.
- Each skiff must carry a suitable bailer.
- A safety briefing will take place prior to the start of the race which all crews **must be** present for.
- A decision will be made on the day by 7am if there is to be a change of course, due to weather. The change of course will be to the Picton Harbour Course. The contact person detailed on the entry form will be contacted and advised of this. The contact person is then responsible for advertising the crew members.
