Safety Plan

- All skiffs will carry bow numbers and balls
- Each bow crew member **must** wear hi vis shirt or vest
- Life preservers **must** be carried for each crew member in each skiff

Supervision / Safety Craft

(Minimum of 2 crew members per vessels)

- Possible harbour masters vessel @ 7 m (inside harbour limits)
- Coastguard vessel @ 7 m – doubles as rescue / emergency vessel
- Private vessel @ 5 m start line and 1 @ 5 m inside harbour
- Race supporters vessels may also be present, all care observed to ensure they do not impede on competitors performance.
- 6m Naiad on course.

Communications

- Advice to Harbour Masters office as early as possible if change of course takes place on the day
- VHF Channel 18 – Picton Harbour radio to be used by all supervising and support vessels on the day for safety and navigation use only
