

2011 QUEENS CUP REGATTA CONDITIONS

1. The regatta will be conducted under the rules of the NZRA and the WRA.
 2. The regatta will also be conducted in accordance with:
 1. NZRA's Water and Competition Safety Codes.
 2. WRA's Risk Management Plan.
 3. The entry fees (GST exclusive) are: singles, \$5.00; doubles/pairs, \$10.00; quads/fours \$25.00; eights, \$45.00. WRA will invoice clubs.
 4. All entries are to be made online via rowIT.
 1. Entries close 10:00pm, Tuesday 1 November.
 2. Supplementary entries and online crew changes and scratchings will open after entries close and will close 10:00pm, Thursday 3 November.
 3. Crews scratched after the online system closes must be notified to Regatta Control well before the respective race. Five regatta points will be deducted for each non-start crew that has not been notified as a scratching.
 5. Events as advertised in the regatta programme will be rowed in Novice, Club and Open grades.
 1. Novice and Club grades are according to NZRA Rules.
 2. Open grade is intended for advanced Club, U18, Senior, Premier and Masters Rowers.
 6. All events are to be raced over specified distances [usually 2000m] or as near to as the prevailing safety conditions allow.
 7. Divisions will be rowed in events where more than six entries have been received.
 1. Crews will be drawn according to entry ranking. No 1 crews in first division.
 2. The race umpire may amalgamate divisions when scratchings reduce the field.
 - 8. Boat lane numbers (as displayed in the draw sheet) must be displayed at the bow and be legible to the judges on the shore.**
 9. Lane 1 is the lane nearest the Judges at the finish.
 10. Crews are to wear their registered club uniform.
 - 11. All boats must be fitted with a bow ball.**
 - 12. Coxswains must wear an approved personal floatation device.**
 - 13. Where coxswains are carrying weights, these must not be attached to the body.**
 14. The minimum weight for coxswains is 55kg. Random checks may be made.
 15. Race umpires may remove any crew from the course where their safety is at risk.
 16. The Regatta Committee reserves the right to alter starting times.
 17. Crews proceeding to the start are to keep well clear of the course and follow instructions given from umpire and safety boats.
 18. Crews must be in the Start Zone at least five minutes prior to the scheduled starting time.
 19. Races will start without reference to absentees.
 20. Regatta points: 1st four points; 2nd two points; 3rd one point. Row-over winners will be awarded 4 points provided they complete the course at a racing pace or compete against another event.
 21. Points will be deducted from crews failing to comply with these conditions, whilst **failure to comply with items 8,11,12 or 13 will result in immediate disqualification.**
 22. Any protest is to be made to the Race Umpire at the conclusion of the race. The protest is to be confirmed in writing with payment of deposit to the Regatta Committee as provided in NZRA Rules.
 23. WRA will not be responsible for damage to plant or equipment at the regatta.
