WRA'S STAR SESQUICENTENARY REGATTA CONDITIONS (2016 REDDING SHIELD)

DATE: 3 September 2016 RESERVE DATE: 4 September 2016 PREFERRED VENUE: Lambton Harbour, 500m POINTS TROPHY: Redding Shield

- 1. The regatta will be conducted under the rules of the NZRA and the WRA.
- The regatta will also be conducted in accordance with:
 - a. NZRA's Water and Competition Safety Codes.
 - b. WRA's Risk Management Plan.
- 3. Entry fees (excl GST): 1X, \$5; 2X/2-, \$15; 4X±/4±, \$25; 8+/8X+, \$45. WRA will invoice clubs.
- All entries are to be made online via rowlT.
 - a. Entries close 10:00pm, Tuesday 23 August 2016.
 - b. Late entries close 10:00pm, Monday 29 August 2016.
 - c. Supplementary entries close 10:00pm, Thursday 1 September 2016.
 - d. Crews can be altered or scratched online until 12:00pm, Friday 2 September 2016.
- 5. Crews scratched after the online system closes must be notified to Regatta Control at least 20 minutes before the scheduled race start. **Five regatta points** will be deducted for each non-starting crew that was not properly scratched.
- 6. Events as advertised in the regatta programme will be rowed in Club and Open classes. **2016-17 Season Novice class rowers are excluded from this regatta.**
 - a. All classes are according to NZRA Rules.
 - b. Open class is intended for advanced Club, U18, Senior, Premier and Masters rowers.
- 7. Composite crews may be entered in any event. They will be identified by the club of entry.
- 8. All events are to be raced over specified distances [usually 500m] or as near to as the prevailing safety conditions allow.
- 9. Where less than two entries have been received for an event the event may be cancelled.
- 10. Where more than three entries have been received for an event divisions may be rowed.
 - a. Unless otherwise advised, crews will be drawn according to entry ranking with #1 crews in first division. <u>Clubs should self-seed their crews by crew number.</u>
 - b. The race umpire may amalgamate divisions or events when scratchings reduce the field.
- 11. Boat alpha-lane numbers (as displayed in the draw sheet) must be displayed at the bow and be legible to the judges on the shore. Lane 1 is the lane nearest the Judges at the finish.
- 12. Crews are to wear their registered <u>club uniform</u>.
- 13. Control Commission will be operating.
- 14. Coxswains must weigh in 1-2 hours before their first race. The minimum weight for coxswains is 55kg. Any crew found in breach of this condition will be relegated to finish last in its race.
- 15. All boats must be fitted with a bow ball that complies with NZRA Rules.
- 16. Where coxswains are carrying weights, these must not be attached to the body.
- 17. Coxswains must wear an approved personal floatation device.
- 18. Race umpires may remove any crew from the course where its safety is deemed at risk.
- 19. Failure to comply with items 15, 16 or 17 will result in immediate disqualification.
- 20. The Regatta Committee reserves the right to alter starting times.
- 21. Crews proceeding to the start are to keep well clear of the course and follow instructions given from umpire and safety boats.
- 22. Crews must be in the Start Zone (within 25m from the start line) at least five minutes prior to the scheduled starting time.
- 23. Races will start without reference to absentees.
- 24. Any protest is to be made to the Race Umpire at the conclusion of the race.
- 25. Any appeal is to be made in writing to the Race Committee and accompanied by a \$50 deposit.
- 26. Regatta points (per race): 1st, four points; 2nd, two points; 3rd, one point. Row-over winners will be awarded points provided they complete the course at a racing pace or compete against another event.
- 27. Points will be deducted from crews failing to comply with these conditions.
- 28. WRA will not take responsibility for damage to plant or equipment at the regatta.
