#### **Outline:**

The regatta will held in conjunction with, but independent of, the Concept 2 R2K Singles Regatta

Athletes who have been selected to row for New Zealand Internationally during 2014/5 may enter the Mainland Interprovincial Championships but are encouraged to row in the open class events.

Athletes should, in the first instance, compete for the Province of origin, they may however, compete for the Province in which they are domicile during winter if not required by their own Province.

Associations are restricted to no more than two entries per event

## **Team Structure**

#### <u>U 20 Team</u>

- 8 male and 8 female rowers, with no weight restriction, and 1 coxswain for each crew.
- Members of this team are to be Under 20 on 1<sup>st</sup> Oct 2015.
- Boats classes offered are: Single, double, coxless pair, coxless four and coxless quad

#### Open Team

- 4 male and 4 female rowers, with no weight restriction.
- Boats classes offered are: Double, coxless pair, coxless four (men only), coxless quad (women only)

#### <u>Eight</u>

• Combination of no more than 4 open athletes plus at least 4 under 20 athletes
