2011 Club Regatta

Regatta Date: 3 & 4 December 2011 (Saturday & Sunday)

This is the second Karapiro Regatta for the 2011 - 2012 Season and has to be completed within two days. The program cannot be complex and provide for everyone's needs, but still needs to recognise the full range of athletes and their abilities predominantly in the Auckland, Waikato and Bay of Plenty regions; as it is clubs and schools from these regions that will attend this regatta. The following should be read and borne in mind when reading the following regatta order of events. This Regatta will clash with the Jury Cup in Wanganui and more than likely a regatta at Mercer. On that basis, it is questionable as to whether there will be large numbers attending and the need for an expanded range of events.

Open Grade

- Senior and Premier Grade events will be combined into Open grade
- Very few Senior Club rowers in Clubs - Hard to Justify separate races for them at this time of the season.
- Premier athletes are all in the RPC's or the New Zealand squad.

Club Grade

- Will cater for the Majority of Club based rowers in the regions
- School rowers may use these events if they wish, but they will clash with age based events.

Novice Grade

- Novice grade is for all novice rowers regardless of age.
- Recognises that most Novices are pretty much equal at this time of the season under the current novice classification
- Novice doubles have been added to the program for this regatta

Under 16

- Outside of the under 15 age group, the under 16's are the largest age group in the sport.
- On that basis, a separate age group has been provided.
- Will also cater for those second year under 15's
- Will stop last years novices racing this years novice rowers

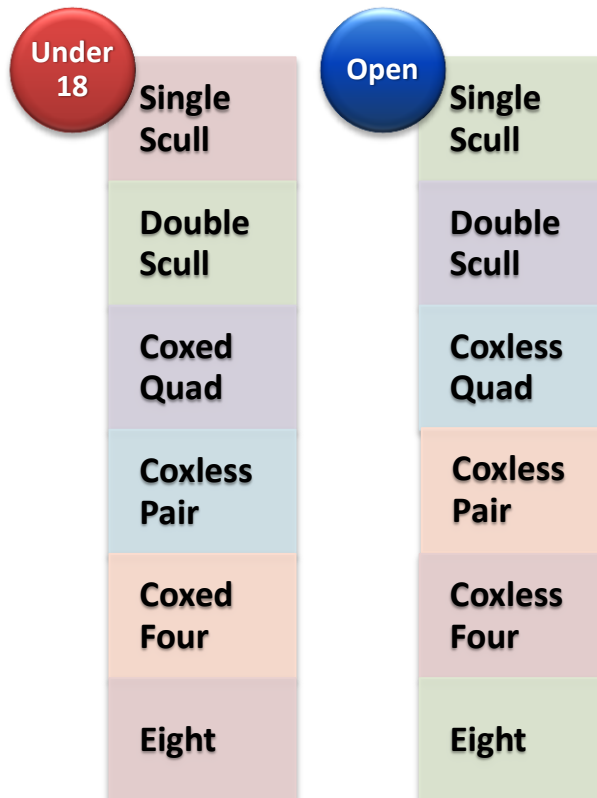
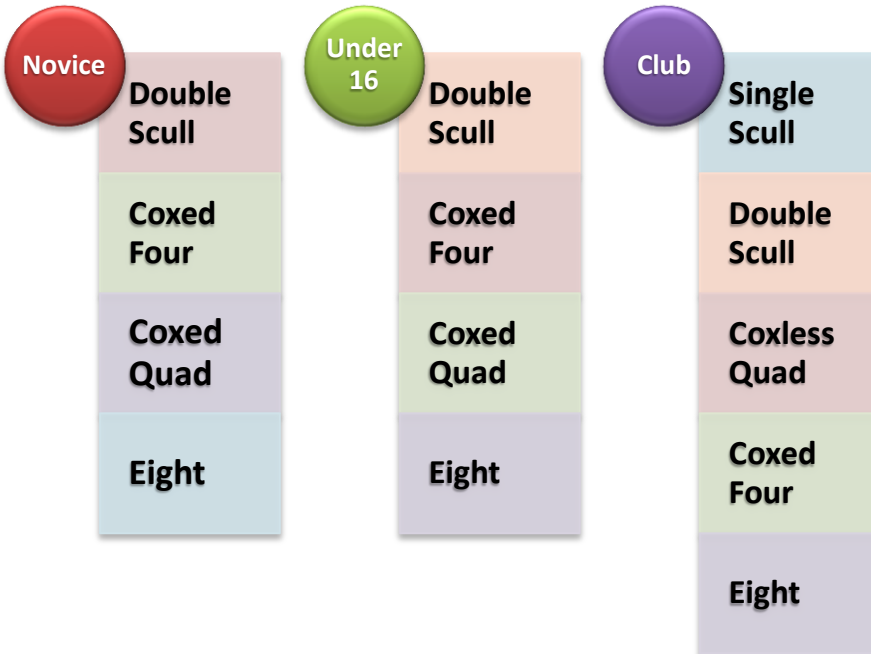
Under 18

- Combined grade for all under 17 and under 18 rowers to compete in.
- Combined under 17 and 18 numbers are still smaller than under 16 number of athletes.

General

- Events have been generally spaced so that if you stay within a class or age group you can row all events of the same discipline.
- Generally, coaches will have to decide whether their athletes are scullers or sweep rowers, but in some cases they will be able to do both.
